Once our slots are full we can no longer accept registrations. **Application Deadline: May 15th.**

Date and Time: Saturday, June 26th, 2010, at 1:00 p.m.

Location: Oregon Convention Center 777 NE Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Portland, OR 97232.

Registration Fee: \$60 for OCEANetwork members \$90 for non members. This fee includes facility use, special speaker, a graduation kit consisting of a cap/gown/diploma and case, and program. Checks can be made out to OCEANetwork and mailed to: 2645 Chuckanut, Eugene, OR 97408.

Cap and Gown Sizing: Our class colors are navy and gold. Each grad will receive a navy cap and gown that will be theirs to keep. The navy gown is lightweight and durable. Cap includes navy-and-gold tassel with graduation year 2010 and is adjustable. Please see sizing below and be careful to order the correct size gown. Alternate sizes will not be available on graduation day. If your student will be wearing heels make sure to take that into consideration with your measurements. Caps and gowns will be received during orientation on Saturday, June 26th.

These pictures will remain the property of OCEANetwork and will not be returned so make sure you have other copies of them. Send high quality scans. *These pictures must be received no later than May 15th to be included.*
